

## Early Years and Key Stage 1 Results 2019

- In Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS), children work towards Early Learning Goals and are assessed in 7 areas of learning. Children who have met the Early Learning Goals have achieved a 'good level of development' (GLD)
- In Year 1, phonics is rigorously taught each morning and in June, all Year 1 children take a statutory phonics screening check.
- In June 2019, the percentage of children achieving GLD was 70%, in line with national average, from an on entry baseline of 40%. Children in EYFS therefore made good progress.
- In Year 1, 77% passed the phonics check, slightly below but broadly in line with national average. 100% of pupils in Year 2 who were retested, passed the check.
