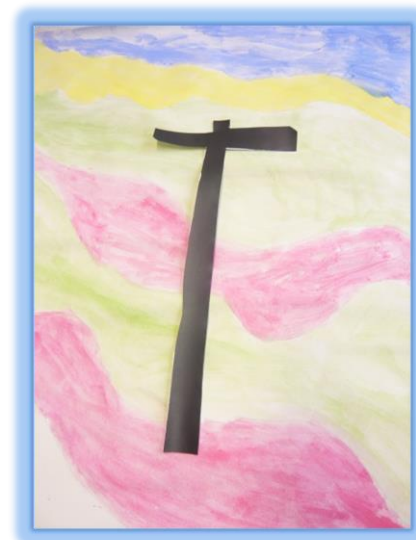




## Collective Worship Themes 2018-2020

### based on Values for Life – Roots and Shoots



Hartest CE Primary School is part of the St Edmundsbury and Ipswich Diocese Multi Academy Trust. Our Collective Worship is based on Roots and Shoots by Imaginor publishing. We explore 12 Christian values over a two year programme of fully creative material. Throughout the year we have whole school RE themed days including Harvest, Christmas and Easter. We also link our RE to learning about our school values and celebrate these in Collective worship.

Collective worship occurs each morning before class teaching and gives the children a chance to explore Christian themes reflecting upon what these mean to them personally as well as to others. Once a week Reverend Prigg leads Collective worship and 'Open the Book' join us regularly to act out one of the stories from the Bible with the children. We have a weekly values collective worship, where the children are very much involved as well as a weekly celebration service. At the end of each term we hold a service at our local church to which parents are warmly invited. The

children also lead the community act of Remembrance at the war memorial in November.

The children have the opportunity to visit Bury Cathedral to access the Discovery Centre as well as join in the Schools Cathedral Service. We also visit places of worship of other faiths.
