# Hartest CE Primary School Curriculum

Our aim is to provide our children with an engaging, exciting and empowering curriculum that equips them for today and tomorrow.

At Hartest Church of England Primary School the curriculum is designed to:

- recognise children's prior learning,
- provide first hand learning experiences,
- allow the children to develop interpersonal skills,
- build resilience and become creative, critical thinkers.

Every child is recognised as a unique individual. We celebrate and welcome differences within our school community. The ability to learn is underpinned by the teaching of basic skills, knowledge, concepts and values with a vision to prepare them for life beyond primary school. We constantly provide enrichment opportunities to engage learning. We believe that childhood should be a happy, investigative and enquiring time in our lives, where there are no limits to curiosity and there is a thirst for new experiences and knowledge.

Underpinning everything we do are our focus on vocabulary, BLP (Building Learning Power), our Christian and British Values, as well as life skills. Our aim is to ensure that our children have the resilience to overcome barriers, are equipped to be effective learners and have the social skills to be valuable and caring members of the community.

Our curriculum is driven by Substantive Knowledge, the knowledge that the children learn during lessons, and Disciplinary Knowledge, the subject specific skills. The Disciplinary Knowledge has been underpinned by 'Big Ideas'. By leading pupils to consider the context in which they will use their understanding, concept-based learning brings real world meaning to content, knowledge and skills.

### English

Reading also enables pupils both to acquire knowledge and to build on what they already know. All the skills of language are essential to participating fully as a member of society; pupils, therefore, who do not learn to speak, read and write fluently and confidently are effectively disenfranchised.

#### RE

At Hartest CE Primary School we believe that all pupils have an entitlement to learn about and from the key concepts underpinning religion and belief. Through a carefully structured curriculum pupils come to understand about themselves, the world, ideas and practices that have shaped and continue to shape their world.

### History

Our History curriculum is designed to equip children with a chronological knowledge (illustrated through timelines) and understanding of local, national and global events. Our children will develop an understanding of the lives and experiences of different people in the context of broader historical narratives.

### Geography

Our Geography curriculum is designed to equip children with a knowledge of places (illustrated through use of maps) and understanding of the similarities and differences between local, national and global locations. ### Forest School

We consider opportunities to learn outside as an essential element of the curriculum. We have a dedicated outdoor area for all classes so that we can offer two classes an afternoon of Forest School learning each week. These sessions have a half termly identified curriculum focus for example PSHE, Science or Geography. Our curriculum cycles reflect this and identified Forest Schools focused topics can be seen in the curriculum overviews.
