TT Rockstar Day - Thursday 29th September

On <u>Thursday, 29th September</u> our school will be having a <u>Times Tables</u> Rockstars Day! We will be carrying out lots of fun games and activities based around learning times tables and launching our use of the TT Rockstar program for the year.



Over the past few of years, pupils from Year 2 upwards have been using the

TTRockstars program to practise their multiplication skills. They have all been given an account on TT Rockstars in order to practise their tables. In doing so, most pupils have their own rock star avatar and rock name. This year, we will be using TT Rockstars to ensure that our children are confident with recalling the tables number facts. Our younger children will be using the opportunity to focus on numbers and number bonds.

As part of the day, pupils can **dress up as a rock star**. We think it will be a fun day which the children will remember as well as encouraging the children to practise their times tables!
