
## Bank Holiday – Monday 8<sup>th</sup> May 2023

### Forest School - Hedgehogs


On Friday, during our Open Afternoon for new parents, Hedgehogs were at Forest School. Thank you to all the children in Squirrels for sharing their learning with me.
