What have we been learning this week?

What a great first week back! The children have been focussed and engaged with their learning. They were all very excited to talk about their Easter break. Thank you to those who encouraged their children to take part in the Easter Writing Challenge!

<u>English</u> — This week the children have been drafting their recount writing using their plan. The children were encouraged to use sound mats and resource sheets to support their independent writing.

<u>Maths</u> — This week the Year 1 and 2 children have continued their learning about multiplication and division. The children have been sharing and grouping and using manipulatives to support their understanding as well as proving their knowledge. Reception children were focussing on the number 6. They went on a mini beast hunt and looked for animals that had 6 legs.

<u>Geography</u> — On Tuesday, we started our new topic of 'Oceans and seas'. The children completed a cold task to demonstrate what knowledge they have already about the topic.

<u>Science</u> — We begun our new topic of 'Plants' this week. The children demonstrated what prior knowledge they have about plants by completing a cold task. I was very impressed with how much knowledge some children have!

<u>P.E.</u> — On Monday we started our new topic of 'Athletics'. The children relayed a beanbag whilst balancing it on different parts of their bodies. All children demonstrated excellent control and teamwork.

<u>R.E.</u> — We have started our new Christianity topic this week. The children talked about who they trusted and why.

<u>Forest School</u> — This week the children enjoyed their session back on the forest school site. They sat around the fire and shared a hot chocolate and a hot cross bun that had been toasted on the fire.
