#### **Mrs Woolmer**

This week I have had several conversations with parents about carrying children in cars.

It appears that across Hartest and Long Melford, there are families who are unclear about the law around children in cars.

This is what the Department of Transport Guidance says:

- 1. Children must normally use a car seat until they are 12 years old or 135cm.
- 2. All children must wear a seatbelt when travelling in a car. Each child should have their own seatbelt and should sit in a separate seat.
- 3. A child ages 3 or over can travel in the back seat without a child seat and without a seatbelt if the vehicle does not have one.
- 4. The rules for vans are the same as cars.
- 5. Children under 3 years must be in a child car seat. Where there is no room for a third child car seat in the back of the vehicle, the child must travel in the front seat with the correct child car seat. Children aged 3 years or older can sit in the back using an adult belt.

It has been brought to my attention that this week we have had children sharing seats and seatbelts and children standing behind the driver or passenger seats whilst the vehicle is moving.

Our school works to ensure that we keep all our children safe at all times: children standing whilst the vehicle is moving and children sharing seatbelts and seats is <u>not</u> safe.

If I hear of any further incidents, I will have no option but to share the information with Social Care.

### **Children of the World**


Today was the world premiere of the song which is now live on YouTube! Well done Kestrel Class!
