Healthy Food

As we are developing our new school lunch menu with Aspens as well as teaching our PE, PHSE and DT curriculum of healthy food choices we are encouraging all children to choose healthy options for their snack and lunch.

Snacks

Breaktime snack for Hedgehog class are provided by the school, these usually consist of a range of fruit and vegetables however if your child does not like the selection that week they are welcome to bring in their own fruit or vegetable snack. Squirrels and Kestrel class are encouraged to bring in their own healthy fruit or vegetable snack.

Lunch Boxes

To encourage our healthy eating, we are asking the children to pick healthier options in their lunch boxes.

As you can see from the school lunch menu below there are a variety of options throughout the week including a dessert. A typical lunch box should consist of the following:

- Sandwich/pasta/cold pizza/ wraps/ pitta etc
- Crisps/crackers
- Fruit/vegetables (grapes need to be halved)
- Cold chicken bites or meat sticks
- Dessert Yoghurt/jelly/ small biscuit or cake bar

To ensure fairness between all children we ask that sweet treats are kept for after school or weekends.


Apologies for the late Weekly Update this was due to the very wet weather we all endured last Friday.
